

Ainomo DMCA Policy

Introduction

Ainomo respects the intellectual property rights of others and is committed to helping third parties protect their rights. Our DMCA Policy outlines the process by which Ainomo responds to notices of alleged copyright infringement on platforms it controls, including websites hosting user-generated content, as mandated by the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA), 17 U.S.C. §512.

Reporting Copyright Infringement

If you believe that your copyrighted work has been copied or made accessible on an Ainomo service in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, please notify Ainomo's DMCA agent as described below. Your notice must be in writing and include the following information:

1. **A physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.**
2. **Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed, or if multiple copyrighted works at a site are covered by a single notification, a representative list of such works.**
3. **Identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing or to be the subject of infringing activity and that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit Ainomo to locate the material.**
4. **Information reasonably sufficient to permit Ainomo to contact the complaining party, such as an address, telephone number, and, if available, an email address at which the complaining party may be contacted.**
5. **A statement that the complaining party has a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.**
6. **A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.**

Please note that under Section 512(f) of the DMCA, any person who knowingly materially misrepresents that material or activity is infringing may be subject to liability.

Counter-Notification

If you believe that your content was removed or disabled by mistake or misidentification, you may provide Ainomo with a written counter-notification containing the following information:

1. **Your physical or electronic signature.**
2. **Identification of the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled and the location at which the material appeared before it was removed or access to it was disabled.**
3. **A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the material was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification of the material.**
4. **Your name, address, and telephone number, and a statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the federal court for the judicial district in which the address is located, or if your address is outside of the United States, for any judicial district in which Ainomo may be found, and that you will accept service of process from the person who provided notification of the alleged infringement.**
